Key Areas of Learning

As Geographers & Historians we will:

study the rainforests of the world, their global locations and their climate. We will study their amazing and diverse ecology, the civilizations that have called them home and the many uses humans have found for rainforests and their inhabitants. Finally, we will look at some of the threats facing rainforests today and the importance of protecting them for the benefit of the whole planet.

As Scientists we will be taught to:

Identify that animals, including humans, need the right types of nutrition, and that they cannot make their own food; they get nutrition from what they eat. We will look into what makes a healthy diet and the impact of good and bad foods upon our bodies. We will also study teeth and the digestive system and their involvement in eating, food and nutrition. Finally, we will identify that humans and some other animals have skeletons and muscles for support, protection and movement.
