People, Culture and Communities	Talk about members of their immediate family and community. 	Name and describe people who are familiar to them. Listens carefully to stories about different places and is beginning to recognise that different places have different features, e.g. Long Hanbrough has a river but some places are by the sea. Knows about some celebrations and is able to talk about how they might be celebrated, e.g. Christmas, Advent, Diwali.	Recognise that people have different beliefs and celebrate different times in different ways. Recognise some similarities and differences between life in this county and life in other countries. Has a developing understanding of the wider world and draws comparisons between own local environment/ community and other places. Looks at, and makes maps, of local environment. Describes a journey within the local environment.	<u>ELG People, Culture and Communities</u> Know some similarities and differences between different religious and cultural communities in this country, drawing on their experiences and what has been read in class. <u>ELG People, Culture and Communities</u> Explain some similarities and differences between life in this country and life in other countries, drawing on knowledge from stories, nonfiction texts and (when appropriate) maps.
			<u>Beyond ELG</u> Understand that different people have different beliefs, attitudes, customs and traditions and why it is important to treat them with respect.
